

DERBY RECREATION COMMISSION
ASA SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT
RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Tournament director reserves the right to change format or cancel tournament if extenuating circumstances necessitate such action. In the case of inclement weather please call the DRC at 316-788-3781, for tournament updates.
2. All teams are to check in at High Park before your first game. Game time, brackets, rosters and fees must be cleared before team will be permitted to participate. Roster MUST be turned in by the first game.
3. All teams are required to be ready to play at least 15 minutes before each game. Game time is forfeit time. A team must have eight (8) players at start of game.
4. Protests: No protests will be accepted on official judgment calls or decisions. Protests on rule interpretations will be considered immediately by the tournament director and his committee; their decision will be final. Teams will abide by this and continue to play. **NO EXCEPTIONS-NO REFUNDS.** Protest fee-\$50.
5. On questions concerning player eligibility, proper proof of identification will be required. Players not able to show such proof will be declared ineligible and the team dealt with per the rulebook.
6. No change to a team's roster will be allowed after the team has begun to play in its first game during a tournament.
7. Official sanctioning rules, regulations and umpires will apply to all appropriate tournaments.
8. A 15-run rule after three innings and an 8-run rule after five innings will be in effect in all games including championship games. **(See attached for 10U rules.)**
9. Tournament refunds will be: 100% if tournament is cancelled, 50% if one game is played. No refunds after two games have been played.
10. Players, managers, and spectators are not protected by any medical insurance while on our sports complex property. However, softball teams may purchase yearly medical coverage through the ASA.
11. The Derby Recreation Commission, the City of Derby or Derby Recreation Commission and its management assume no responsibility for injuries that might happen during tournaments while at High Park.
12. Managers are responsible for their teams and are responsible in making sure that all players are aware of all of the above rules and regulations for participation in the ASA and Derby Recreation Commission softball fields in Derby.
13. Tournament fees are to be paid no later than deadline date. No refunds after the brackets have been drawn.
14. No re-entry rule will be in effect. Tournament will use free defensive substitution. Teams may bat the entire roster.
15. All prizes and awards are subject to change based on a minimum number of entries.
16. **NO** alcoholic beverages allowed in the complex.
17. Games will have a 1 hour 15 minute time limit with the exception of championship games which will be 1 hour and 30 minutes.
18. 60 seconds allowed between innings.
19. Home team will provide official bookkeeper, visiting team will provide scoreboard operator.
20. Home team will be decided by a coin toss at the beginning of each game.
21. Placement in bracket determined by:
 - a. Head to head
 - b. Fewest runs allowed in all games
 - c. Most runs scored in all games
 - d. Coin toss

***Gate fee \$4 for Adults, \$3 for 12 years and under.**

10U RULE REMINDERS

22. May steal only 1 base at a time.
23. To score, the runner must be walked in or hit in.
24. No running on dropped 3rd strikes.
25. The infield fly rule is in effect.
26. 6 runs per inning limit (all innings).
27. An 8-run rule after four innings will be in effect in all games including championship games.
